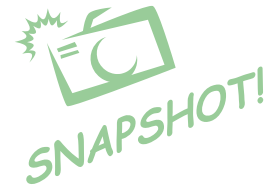

Senior High Knowledge Bowl, often called a sport for the mind, is an interdisciplinary academic contest designed for students in **grades 9 –12**. Teams of students compete in written and oral rounds by answering questions related to all areas of learning typical of high school educational programs. Questions test students' recall, problem solving, and critical thinking skills. Participation takes quick thinking and teamwork, and, like all team sports, students learn to work together to reach their goal.

The Senior High Knowledge Bowl season begins in January with three regular season meets followed by Subregional and Regional meets. The registration deadline for the regular season is in November. Following the regional meets, the state meet provides an exciting finale at Cragun's Resort in Brainerd.

Knowledge Bowl was introduced by the Minnesota Service Cooperatives in 1979 with 8 high schools participating. Enthusiastic support has increased its numbers to over 863 high school teams from 278 schools and districts statewide. In 2014-2015, 500+ metro area high school students (107 teams) from 29 metro area high schools participated in the program.

The metro area Knowledge Bowl program is coordinated by Success Beyond the Classroom in collaboration with Metro ECSU.
